



CONSENT FORM

Sparrow Wealth Management (“SWM”) needs your written permission to share your tax and financial information with your accountant/tax preparer (“Tax Preparer”). If you consent to the disclosure of your tax return information, federal law may not protect your tax return information from further use or distribution.

You are not required to complete this form. If SWM or your Tax Preparer obtains your signature on this form by conditioning services on your consent, your consent will not be valid. If you agree to the disclosure of your tax return information, your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year from the date of your signature.

By your authorization below, you confirm that you have requested your Tax Preparer (as stated below) to disclose your tax return information to SWM so that we can better provide financial planning and investment advice to you. The information disclosed may include all information contained within, or derived from, your current or prior tax return(s), unless you request in writing a more limited disclosure.
